Fresh Schools

FOR NEW STUDENTS ENTERING THE SCHOOL:

STUDENTS WITH EXISTING ACCOUNTS -- PLEASE ASSIGN YOUR CHILD/CHILDREN'S NEW CLASSROOM:

- 1. Log into Fresh Schools via a DESKTOP computer only (the app will not work for the following instructions). Search for your child using the search bar in the top right.
- 2. Click on your child's name.
- 3. Click the "pencil" icon in the top right window of your child's profile.
- 4. In the "Classes" field start typing the name of your child's teacher. Select the teacher name.
- 5. Scroll all the way down and click "Save Profile"
